Protects Against	Diphtheria, tetanus, pertussis, polio, and Haemophilus influenzae type b (Hib)
Routine Schedule	Four (4) dose series: 2, 4, 6, and 15-18 months
Minimum Intervals	4 week minimum interval between dose 1 and 2 4 week minimum interval between dose 2 and 3 6 month minimum interval between dose 3 and 4 (as determined by DTaP component)
Approved Ages	Children aged 6 weeks through 4 years
Administration	Intramuscular (IM) injection
Packaging	Vaccine is packaged as 5 single-dose vials 0.5mL of DTaP-IPV liquid component and 5 single-dose vials of lyophilized Hib component
Storage	Refrigerate between 36°F and 46°F (2°C to 8°C) Do Not Freeze
