Is your practice prepared?

✓ Review and update your <u>Vaccine Management Plan</u>
 ✓ Test your emergency systems and check your supplies
 ✓ Make sure *all* staff are trained, not just new staff

Depending on the event, you may need to <u>transport vaccines</u>.
√ Practice the steps you'll need to take, including conditioning cold packs. Don't risk spoiling vaccines by exposing them to out-of-range temps during transport.
