

Vaccine Tips

It's just as important to document vaccines correctly as it is to administer them correctly.

Record these elements for every vaccine you administer:

- vaccine manufacturer
- vaccine lot number
- date the vaccine is administered
- name, office address, and title of the person giving the vaccine
- VIS publication date
- date the VIS is given to the patient/parent/guardian

Report vaccine errors to <u>VERP</u> and adverse events to <u>VAERS</u>.
