## If your data logger download looks like this:

## Then it's time to replace it.

- ✓ Do not recalibrate data loggers that download into an Excel or CSV file.
- ✓ Replace with a data logger that downloads a Summary Report.

Summary Reports will reduce time needed to report temperature excursions by accurately displaying at a glance:

- recorded temperature data since the device was last reset,
- the total time temperatures have been out of range,
- minimum and maximum temperatures, and
- alarm settings.

A properly configured data logger that meets VFC requirements will help ensure your vaccines are stored appropriately. For more information, refer to the California VFC Program Provider Operations Manual.
