


Vaccine Tips

March 2014

Daily temperature monitoring is <u>essential</u> to vaccine management.



- VFC recently revised the temperature logs (IMM-1125 and IMM-1126). Use the most current versions.
- Record current, minimum and maximum temperatures twice a day.
- If ANY recorded temperatures are in a DANGER ZONE (even if the current temp is okay), take immediate action and document actions on the log.
