

Vaccine Tips

Vaccines won't work if they're not stored at the right temperatures!

Check the temperature in your vaccine fridge and freezer every morning and at the end of the day.

Use a second (back-up) thermometer to make sure your primary thermometer is working.

Replace thermometer batteries when you change the clocks, e.g. every fall and every spring.
