

# Vaccine Fact Sheet: Mpox

Manufacturer	Bavarian Nordic A/S <a href="#">Prescribing Info (FDA)</a>
Protects Against	Smallpox & monkeypox disease
Approved Ages	18 years & older determined to be at high risk for smallpox or monkeypox infection
Funding Source	<b>VFC</b> California Vaccines for Children Program
Routine Schedule	2 doses 4 weeks apart
Minimum Intervals	28 days between doses
Administration	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Allow vaccine to thaw and come to room temperature before use</li> <li>Swirl vial gently for at least 30 seconds before withdrawing a dose</li> </ul> <p><b>Subcutaneous:</b> 0.5mL to back of upper arm</p>
Packaging	Vaccine packaged as 10 single-dose vials per carton
Storage	Keep frozen between -25°C and -15°C (-13°F and 5°F). Protect from light. Once thawed, store between 2°C and 8°C (36°F and 46°F) for 4 weeks. <b>Do not refreeze once thawed.</b>
